Coaches Report

Last years report started off highlighting that AS would be without their main pool at the University for the majority of the season. Many would have seen this as a huge negative and allowed this to influence the season that followed.

Thankfully, this wasn't the case for AS and we found adequate pool time to sustain the training needs of the squads throughout the closure. Recognition for this should be made to Anne and Mark Lawton for tirelessly approaching all the pools we eventually used, also to Emma Head for brokering the land training space we used at Ralph Allen School, which enabled AS to launch its new land training programme. Additional thanks must go to John Watson (Bath NTC) for devising the plan and to Mellissa Hardern, George Buckney and Mike Muckelt for the delivery of this programme in assisting the swimmers development.

Where a reduction in pool time may have proved a disaster for some programmes, we supplemented these hours with the land training and had tremendous success in the competition arena. Aqua Sulis had 6 swimmers qualify for the British Champs, with 5 competing. We had 3 swimmers make Junior finals with 3rd, 4th and 5th place finishes, all in pb times, a tremendous set of achievements.

This carried through the Regional and National/Home Nation Champs as well. Aqua Sulis was well represented on the medal podium and in final placings. It's worth noting that from the summer competitions we achieved a British, Scottish, English, Welsh and New Zealand national champions!!

We also broke new ground towards the end or last season in employing Suzi Bowen as our new Assistant Head Coach. Suzi comes to us with a wealth of knowledge and a proven track record with in age group swimming. Suzi will take charge of the Junior Performance and Development squads, where she will be assisted by another new member of staff in Liam Willcox.

- 10 Medals at Welsh Home Nation Champs – 3 Gold, 4 Silver, 4 Bronze
- 3 Medals at New Zealand National Champs – 2 Gold, 1 Silver
- 3 British Champs Junior finalist
- British Summer Champs finalists
- English Home Nation Champs finalists
- Scottish Home Nation Champs finalists
- Welsh Home Nation Champs finalists
- 1 selection for Englant Talent Programme
- 2 selections for AASE Programme

In addition, I have recently been selected for the England Programmes Talent camps. We also have 1 assistant coach who has completed the UKCC Level 3, 2 other assistants currently on the course, as well as 1 assistant completing their UKCC Level 2 and another about to complete the same course.
